What Are Hive Beetles

What they do to a hive

How to stop them

- Using swiffers pad help when cutting the pad into squares then put the cut pads over the brood frames and at the top of the hive where hive beetles usually stay
 - keep the hive onto high ground because this makes it harder for the beetles to get to the hive
